OPEN ENROLLMENT

Open Enrollment allows parents and guardians who live within TUSD boundaries to apply for their children to attend a school other than their home school. For the 2018-2019 school year, applications must be completed & returned to the Family Welcome Enrollment Center (FWEC) **Jan. 8 thru Feb. 28 at 4:00 pm** for elementary and middle schools. Late applications will **NOT** be accepted. If you are here at Arnold on a Boundary Waiver, or as an overflow from another school, you must apply for Open Enrollment in order to have the chance to stay at Arnold for the 2018-2019 school year. Completion of an application does NOT guarantee acceptance, as Open Enrollment is granted on a lottery basis. Complete instructions and applications are available [online](#).
